DEPOT DAYS FESTIVAL VENDOR RULES AND REGULATIONS



The Sponsors of this event wish to provide the best venue possible for all attendees without prejudice to any vendor, exhibition, crafter, attendee or visitor.

Rules and Regulations will be enforced by the City of Newbern to provide a Family oriented function of the highest standards, functionality & morality without bias.

Returning vendors: Returning vendors receive first priority in application acceptance and space locations. Returning vendors payment must be provided by the July 1st deadline to ensure participation and reserve same spot as last year. After this date, all spaces remaining unpaid will open up to new vendors for exception in the order they are received. We try not to duplicate products as the Depot Days Festival intends to provide the largest variety of items to attendees, however some similar common items may be sold with approval from the Event Coordinator. Certain companies allow only one single representative of their product at a single event and we follow these same guidelines for the independent companies as well.

No Vulgar, obscene or Offensive Materials may be displayed. This is a morally based family event. Anyone not in compliance with this rule will be required to remove all articles from sight. If compliance is not met, removal of entire booth may be required. Removal is solely at the decision of the Vending Coordinator without exception.

Declined Applications: Vendors not chosen based on lack of space, duplication of vending items or independent sales companies will receive a full refund of the application fee by mail.

Hours of Operation: Set-up will be as follows: Friday 8:00pm-10:00pm and Saturday 6:00am-8:30am. Vending opens at 9:00am sharp. All vehicles must be cleared from the street no later than 8:30am. No Food or Vendor Trailers will be allowed for any reason after 8:30am. Accommodations are based solely at the decision of the Vending Coordinator without exception.

Closing or breakdown is NOT ALLOWED before 8:00pm NO EXCEPTIONS unless prior arrangements have been made. For the safety of our Festival Attendees this will not be tolerated. Not adhering to this rule will result in not being allowed to return to this Festival. Streets must be cleared of all vendor activity prior to 11:00pm

All vendors and exhibitors are required to collect and pay Tennessee Sales tax. Festival sponsors assume no liability or responsibility for exhibitors' compliance with sales tax requirements. Tennessee sales tax web address is www.tn.gov/revenue.

Entertainment All entertainment will be booked and furnished by the festival sponsors. No other sound equipment will be allowed.

All concession vendors must be in compliance with State of Tennessee Health Department regulations. Failure to comply will result in removal from the Festival with no refund.

Extention cords must be sufficiently covered in order not to provide tripping or electrical shock hazards. No sales will be permitted on festival grounds except by authorized exhibitors. NO travel through sales are permitted.

The only generators allowed within the festival will be the small, quiet ones such as predator 3500 or quiet Hondas. Loudgenerators will not be permitted and is at the discretion of the Vendor Coordinator.
